WILLIAM T. KANE, DDS, MBA graduated from UMKC in 1980. He maintains a general practice in rural Dexter MO. In addition to practicing dentistry, Dr. Kane's interest and passion have been in the area of recovery and wellness. He served as Chairman of the Dental Well Being Committee for the Missouri Dental Association (MDA) from 1987 to 2016 as well as being a member of the Dental Wellness Advisory Committee with the American Dental Association. Dr. Kane is very familiar with issues facing dental professionals and patients with addictive diseases. He also completed an MBA in 1992 from Southeast Missouri State Univ. In 2013, Dr. Kane was selected by the MDA as "Missouri Dentist of the Year". In May 2016, Dr. Kane was appointed to serve on the Missouri Dental Board, where he served as President in 2018 and 2019. Currently he is the Representative of the Missouri Dental Board on The Prescription Drug Monitoring Task Force. Dr. Kane co-founded The Smiles of Hope Clinic in Dexter in 2010 that provides emergency dental care for individuals who have difficulty accessing care.



He enjoys mentoring young pre-dental and dental students as they enter and progress through dental school. In his free time, Dr. Kane is as waterfowl hunting enthusiast and traveling with his family.
